5. To formally receive the RAF Waddington, Flying Training Station Commemorative Print. This was gifted to the people and Town Council of Droitwich Spa by Phillip Wilde MBE having served 30 years in the Royal Air Force. The Squadron Print was recently presented to Councillor Mrs Sital Harris at a visit to 2516 (Droitwich) Squadron Air Training Corps.
6. Letter from Mrs Joyce Holliday – To acknowledge appreciation for the memorial trophy provided by the Town Council for the late Mr Frank Holliday. *[ for information only]*
7. Rebranding Launch Event of the Worcester to Birmingham Bus, route 144. This will be the main and first such event of four – Droitwich Spa, Birmingham, Worcester and

Bromsgrove. The theme of the rebrand for this express route is the 'Salt Road'. The profile of the rebranding is high and anticipates BBC, media and travel industry press coverage. Full event publicity details to follow from First Bus. The event will comprise of a formal ribbon cutting ceremony by the Mayor between 11.00am and 2.00pm on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> June, location, Victoria Square.

8. To consider the proposal to purchase a new P.A. system for the Community Hall. A suitable portable system is desired similar to the equipment recently loaned by Cllr Brookes. This is required due to the age, obsolete fittings and unreliability of current system. A suitable portable appliance will give the option for Town Council use and provision for room hirers. To accord with protocol three separate quotes will be acquired.
9. Town Market – We have received a recent enquiry from [MM Events Group](#) , with regards to a stand-alone market between 27<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup> June 2018, on Victoria Square. This has been agreed in principle subject to all statutory requirements being met and a site visit with the operator is arranged. A provisional interest has also been expressed by the same operator towards progressing with and re-establishing the Friday weekly Charter market thereafter.
