4. (a) Planning applications *[schedule attached]*
(b) Amended planning applications – Planning reference 19/02210/FUL, Erection of two flats, location- 1 Wych Road, Droitwich Spa, WR9 8BW. Description of additional information/amendment- Amended size of flats and number of parking spaces reduced. The WDC notification dated 14 February requests that any comments on the amendments only are submitted in writing within 14 days. *[notification letter attached for information]*
5. Decisions of the Local Planning Authority:-
 - Approval Notices: Wychavon District Council, the Local Planning Authority, has issued 4 approval notices during the elapsed period since the last Town Council

Planning Committee meeting. Of these 3 did accord with the recommendations of the Town Council Planning Committee and 1 did not.

- Refusal Notices: No refusal notices have been issued by Wychavon District Council during the elapsed period since the last Town Council Planning Committee meeting on 10 February 2020.
6. Worcestershire County Council – Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Section 14 as amended). Notice of further temporary closure of A38 Roman Way, Droitwich Spa to enable S 278 Development Works. Closure is from the junction with the A38 Worcester Road and the A4133 Ombersley Road. Duration is considered for 5 days from 29 February 2020 and the anticipated timescale is 2 days. *[public notice attached for information]*
 7. Worcestershire County Council – Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Section 14 as amended). Notice of temporary closure of U41704 Kidderminster Road and U41705 Union Lane, Droitwich Spa to enable new/replacement water main works. The closures extend as follows ,
 - (a) U 4174 Kidderminster Road – from its junction with U41701 Vines Lane to the junction with U41704 Hampton Road.
 - (b) U41705 Union Lane – from its junction with U41704 Kidderminster Road to the junction with C2254 Ombersley Way.Duration is anticipated to be five days from 24 February 2020. *[public notice, order and map attached for information]*
 8. Worcestershire County Council – Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Section 14 as amended). Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area. Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places. On 20 February 2020 the Order was made to replace limited waiting 45 minutes, no return within 2 hours with limited waiting 15 minutes, no return within 2 hours on the following lengths of road. Queen Street (north west side) from a point 73 metres south west of its junction with Salt Way for a distance of 16 metres in a south westerly direction (south east side) from a point 57 metres south west of its junction with Hanbury Street for a distance of 23 metres in a south westerly direction. The order is operational from 12 March 2020. *[public notice attached for information]*
 9. Worcestershire County Council – Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (Section 14 as amended). First Notice of Order – Road Closure – Blake Avenue, Droitwich Spa. Temporary closure of that part of Blake Avenue from its junction with Celvestune Way to Alexander Avenue to enable new water main connections. Effective 30 March 2020 and anticipated to take 9 days. *[public notice attached for information]*
 10. Office of the West Mercia Police & Crime Commissioner – Draft Road Safety Strategy. The draft document was circulated to all Elected Members on 24 February 2020 for review. There is a supporting online survey for consultation feedback available until 20th March 2020.
